School Advisory Board: (Brian) – Financing for Nature playground and addition of cameras from Home & School. Updates to safety plan (Reunification) April 21st State of the School. Stars Assessment review. Staff turnover discussed. How to retain staff. Enrollment very good. Tuition increases of 2% of '23-24

Finance Committee (John): Budget complete. It was challenging year but successful. Teacher base increasing 3%. 5% increase for other staff members. Sunday offerings budgeted at 35% (which is conservative). Growth of the parish continues to increase. Mass attendance has increased about 200 people each week for the past six weeks. Budget is about -\$244K does not include PPE. 0% increase in health insurance this year. Question on how our teacher's pay compares to public schools. (Goals?) SPIRIT profit ~\$475K
